



ONLY 57 OUT OF EVERY 1000 RAPE REPORTS FILED LEAD TO ARREST.






87-94% OF EMPLOYEES AWARE OF WORKPLACE HARASSMENT DO NOT FILE A REPORT





18% OF COLLEGE STUDENTS THINK SOMEONE HAS CONSENTED AS LONG AS THEY DON'T SAY NO







GREATLY UNDERREPORTED.






95% OF WOMEN ON COLLEGE CAMPUSES REPORTING RAPE REPORT THAT THEIR RAPIST WAS MALE.




SEXUAL + RELATIONSHIP RESPECT COMMITTEE



APPROXIMATELY 80%-90% OF WOMEN REPORTING SEXUAL ASSAULTS KNEW THEIR ASSAILANT.






REASONS FOR NOT REPORTING:

- 20% Feared Retaliation
- 13% Believed the police would not do anything to help
- 2% Believed the police could not do anything to help
- 13% Believed it was a personal matter
- 8% Reported to a different official
- 8% Believed it was not important enough to report
- 7% Did not want the perpetrator to get in trouble
- 30% gave another reason, or cited multiple reasons


